

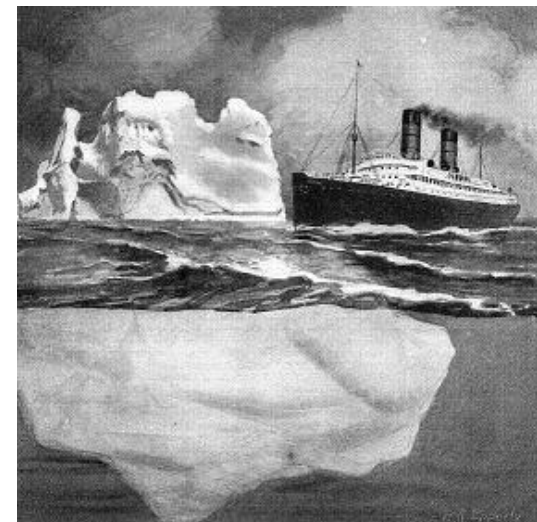


JACK THAYER AND THE WRECK OF THE TITANIC

Official Tells the Moving Story of His Rescue

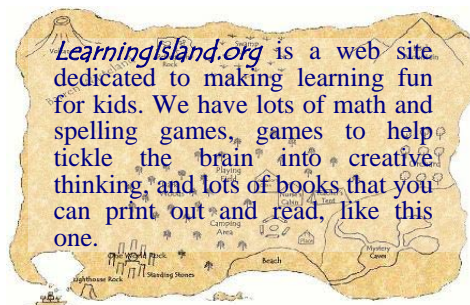
Jack Thayer is the seventeen-year-old son of a railroad official. On April 12, 1914 he was a passenger on the Titanic.
