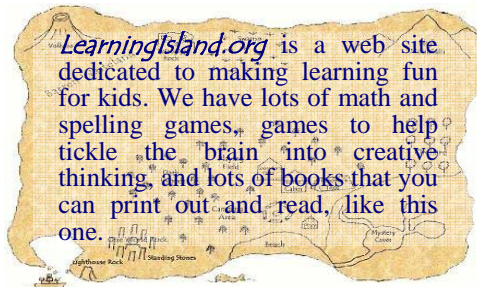

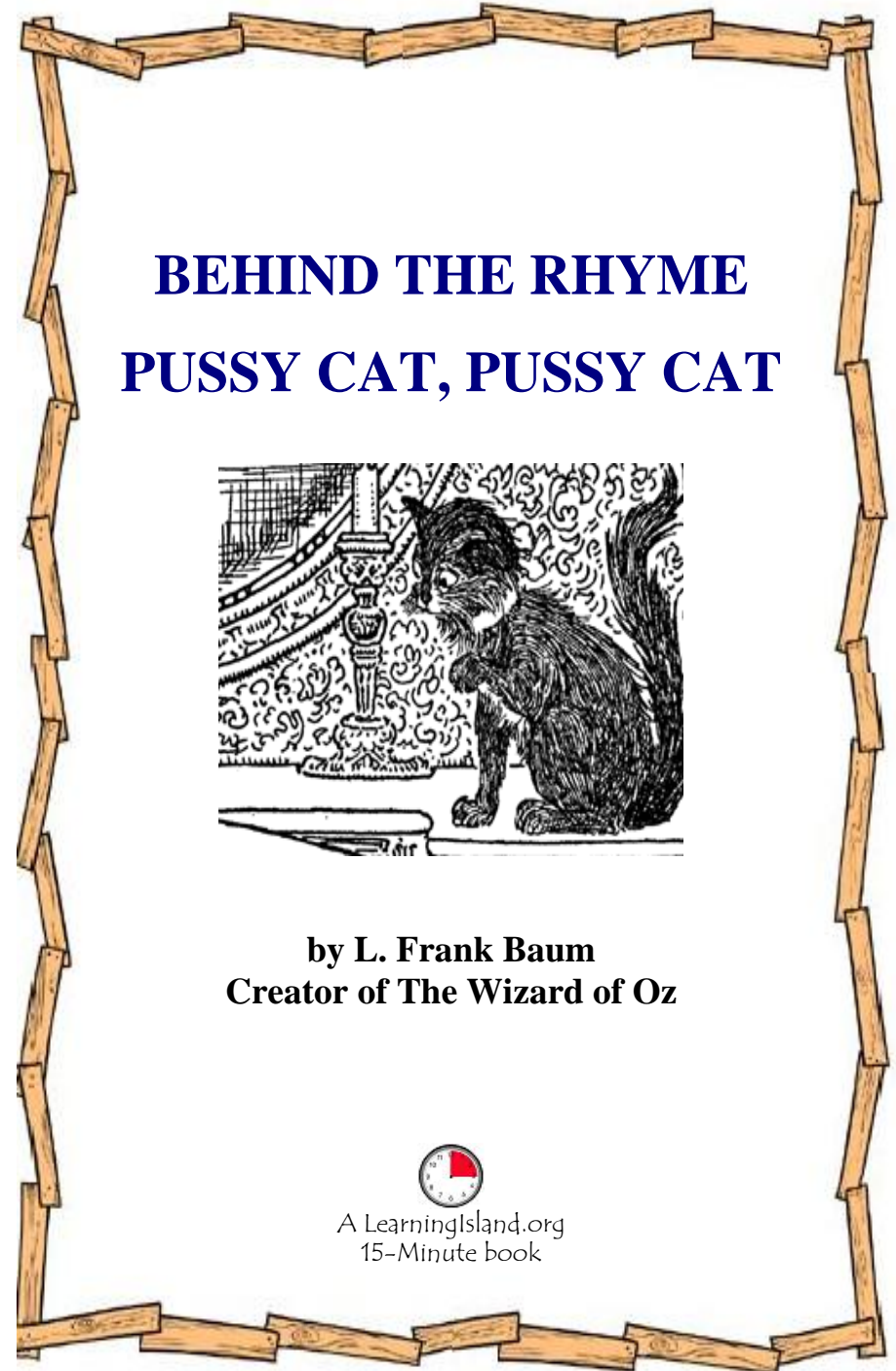

This old children’s nursery rhyme is the last line in this tale of a daring pussy-cat’s explorations to the palace of the queen.

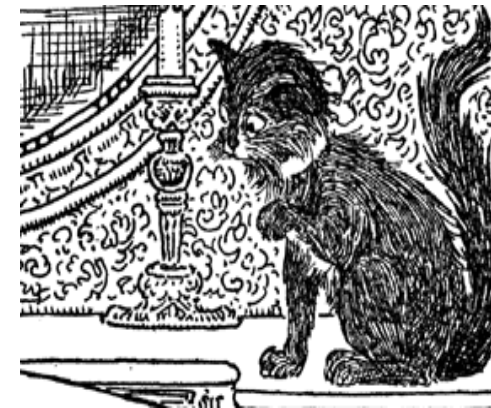
