have you been?”

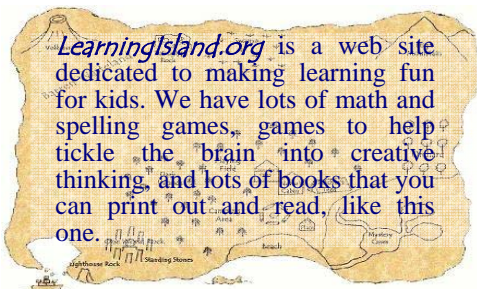
“I’ve been to
