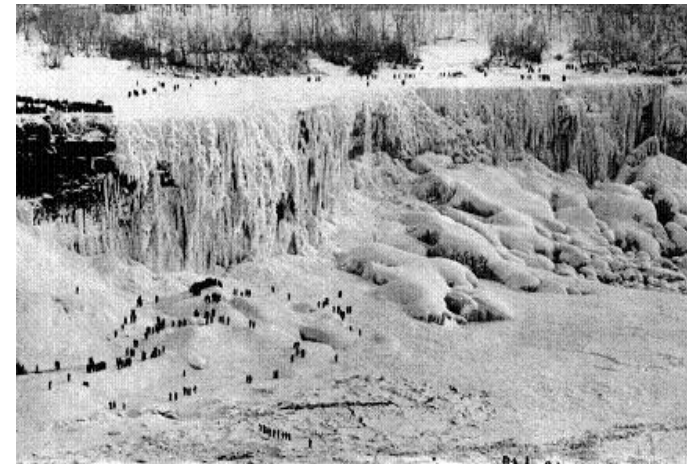


THE DAY NIAGARA FALLS STOPPED RUNNING



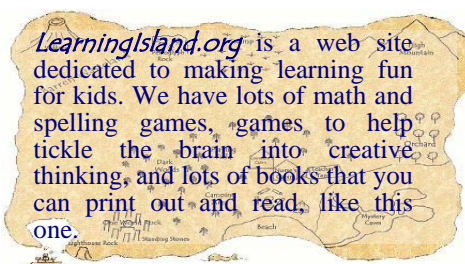
It happened on March 29, 1848. The people of the town of Niagara Falls awoke to a near deafening silence.
