



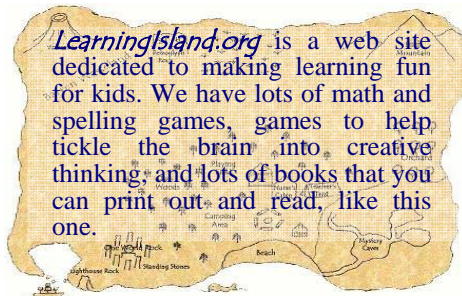
“Beg pardon, sir,” said our pageboy. “There’s been a gentleman here asking for you, sir.”
